

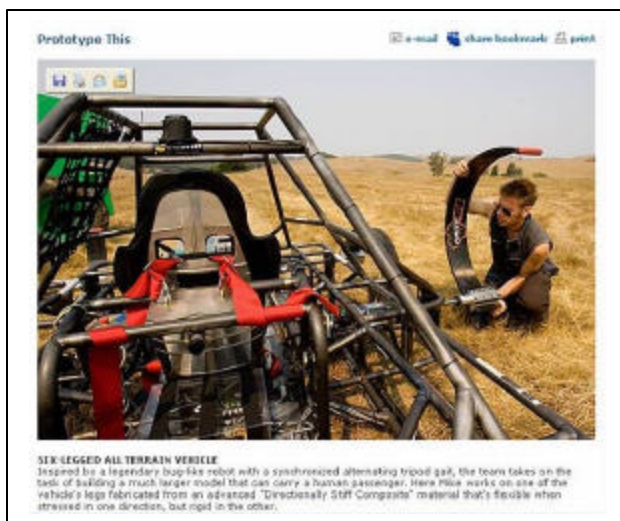


## Parker Gearheads on the Discovery Channel
