All modules now included in the base cost of this HMI software package.

Parker's Interact level-1 HMI product just got better. With the release of Interact version 7.0, users of this powerful and flexible HMI package enjoy a distinct advantage over previous versions.

For years, Interact's unique modular architecture has allowed it to scale from simple push-button replacement applications up to near-SCADA capabilities right on the machine. Yet this flexibility and configurability has always come with a cost: the optional module charge. With the release of Interact 7.0, all modules are now included in the base cost of the Interact package. This new, all-modules-included approach makes configuring PowerStations and Interact applications easier than ever. There is no more confusion about what modules might be necessary for a given application, because Interact 7.0 includes them all!



With this pricing model adjustment, Interact 7.0 represents one of the best values in the HMI market, offering more capability, higher speed of response and more flexibility than any other level 1 HMI. Interact version 7.0 also includes many other functional updates to elements such as user interface, driver updates and example applications.

The PA2 family is being released in parallel with the latest version of Interact; all PA2s will ship with Interact version 7.0 pre-installed. (Please note that PA2 PowerStations *require* Interact version 7.0 to operate.)

Current model PA PowerStations will continue to ship with version 6.17 as standard until approximately one month after the release of Interact 7.0, at which time Interact 7.0 will begin shipping pre-installed.
